COMPLETION OF 3RD AND FINAL PHASE OF DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL IN PONCE INLET

We are pleased to announce that the FINAL phase of debris removal has been completed.

Any remaining C & D and vegetative debris from here forward will be removed by Waste Management on their normally scheduled pickup days:

Monday & Thursday: household garbage (must be bagged)

Monday: recycle (recycling items consist of plastics, paper, glass, cardboard, and aluminum)

Wednesday: vegetative (bag small loose debris and stack large debris no longer than 4 feet in piles for pickup)

Thursday: bulk items

All items for pickup must be placed at the curb no later than 7:00 AM.

12,155 cubic yards of debris was removed by Ashbritt
