

**Post-Matthew Cleanup
Progress Report 10-28-16**

The Town of Ponce Inlet will provide updates on debris removal to local residents through weekly updates on the website and on Facebook. The debris removal trucks will be making two full passes throughout the Town. Atlantic Avenue is a County road and debris pickup is being conducted by Volusia County.

AshBritt has been contracted to pickup storm debris. Ashbritt cannot pickup bagged debris.

As of 10/27/16: **5,148 cubic yards** of debris has been removed by Ashbritt.

In addition, Waste Management will continue to pickup bagged debris throughout the Town under its current contract but not on the normal schedule. If the debris truck has made its first pass on your street, please bag any small remaining piles of debris for Waste Management to pick up. Due to the excessive amount of bagged debris, it may take several weeks for Waste Management to cover the entire Town.
