130800012 08/13/13 (Burglary) – Victim is a part time resident of the area and had her representative report that someone had entered their residence on S. Atlantic Ave. Entry was gained through a side door by prying the bolt lock out to open door. Several items including a bed, television, chairs, and kitchen supplies were taken. Several more expensive items were left behind. Locks were changed on the residence. No forensic evidence has been retrieved at this time. Extra patrols continued at this address during the month of November. Continued checks for non-serialized property continued (including private sales, second hand dealers, social media, etc.), with no matches found to date. Case Continued.

130900002 09/01/13 (Auto Theft) – Victim parked his vehicle in an off beach parking area and left keys hidden near the vehicle. When victim left for a short period to go to the beach, the vehicle was stolen. Two days later the vehicle was recovered by Holly Hill PD. The vehicle was processed and a suspect has been developed. Fingerprints and other evidence lead to the prime suspect in this case however at this time there is only proof of the suspect being in the vehicle and nothing to prove that he took the vehicle. Numerous attempts to locate/contact known suspect have been unsuccessful to date. Case Continued.

130900041 09/30/13 (Carbreak) – Victim reports that she parked her vehicle in a parking garage at her condominium. She left all doors unsecured when leaving the vehicle. When she returned approximately 12 hours later she found that her cell phone (which was left charging in the vehicle) was missing from the cup holder next to her seat. Pawn checks were conducted for the stolen phone with no matches found. No new evidence has been obtained in this case. Case Inactive pending new leads.

CIU MONTHLY STATS

131000004 – 10/04/2013 (Theft) – Victim reported leaving his mountain bike in front of his home unlocked. Bicycle removed overnight, between 1130 PM and 0545 AM, and was valued at \$250. The serial number is not available for the bicycle. No known suspects or witnesses. Neighbor's security camera was not yet in service at time of theft. Pawn checks conducted with negative results. This case possibly related to 131000005 below. Case continued.

131000005 – 10/04/13 (Burglary) – Victim reported that someone entered his lanai area and took two wet suits and a surfboard. Said lanai had been left unsecure during the overnight hours There was no evidence to process. A check of all local surf shops and pawn shops were negative. Pawn, other resource checks were conducted with negative results. Case continued.

131000029 10/25/13 Theft – Suspect stole a small outboard motor off a vessel parking by Sea Love Boat Works. There were no witnesses to the incident and no video surveillance available. We have put out a flyer to other agencies looking for similar cases. No serial number available for the motor. Pawn checks were continued with negative results. Possible suspect footprint evidence was obtained. Case Continued.

131100008 11/05/13 Theft – Victim reports that a wireless router was stolen from a mail room at a local condominium. Victim advised that the router was left by mailboxes and taken by an individual who is unknown. Investigation on case 131200017 may find that this case is related. We have the serial number on missing router and are attempting to match with possible pawns in area. Case Continued.

131100031 11/27/13 Theft – Victim reports that her mailbox is stolen during overnight period. It was not a specialized mailbox and there was no identifying information on it. Check of area found no clues or evidence. Due to the fact that there is no identifying information and nothing to follow-up on case is inactive pending a lead. Case Inactive.

131200002 12/02/13 Theft – Three victims report that mail has been stolen from their mailboxes. In each case they observed suspects taking mail from the mail box. The pieces taken had financial information in them. Contact was made with numerous banks in area and several checks that were stolen were bleached and attempted to be cashed by suspects. Jurisdictions where the attempted cashing's were contacted and all information turned over to them for possible charges. Case continued.

131200017 12/22/13 Theft – This case was opened as a suspicious incident when several open and empty boxes were found in the 4300 blk of S. Atlantic. Investigation found that they had been delivered to the same condominium however different victims. Packing slips were tracked to individual owners and found that the items had been stolen from the mail room of this condo. Video surveillance identified a suspect for this incident. PIPD has been matching up owners with the found packages and all are willing to prosecute. As the victims have come in we have assigned different case numbers to each victim. As of this date we are preparing felony charges against suspect. This case is related to cases: 131200018, 131200019, 131200020, 131200023, 131200028. Case is continued.
