### COMMENTS

130500012 05/14/13 (Theft) – Victim reported that his Rolex Submariner watch was stolen between 3/10 and 3/11, however he did not report the theft until 05/14. The victim stated that he did not report it because he was looking for it. He last saw the watch at his residence in his bathroom. He states that he has had several cleaning ladies working for him, however to date he is reluctant to give us information on possible suspects. He did provide a serial number for the missing watch and it has been entered into NCIC/FCIC as stolen. There are no new leads in this case. The missing watch will remain in NCIC/FCIC as stolen and should it be recovered case will be reopened for investigation. Case Inactive.

130500013 05/14/13 (Theft) – Victim reports that he left his bicycle in the parking garage of a condominium unsecured at a rack. Last time the victim saw the bicycle was 04/01. A check with the condominium association found that they did not remove it during one of their sweeps for unauthorized bicycles. The victim had a serial number for the missing bicycle and it has been entered into NCIC/FCIC as stolen. We were unable to secure any video from garage due to the length of time between when the bicycle was last seen and when it was reported. Bicycles will remain in NCIC/FCIC as stolen and upon report of recovery case will be reopened. Case Inactive.

130500028 05/26/13 (Burglary) – Victim reports that someone entered her residence and took cash, clothes and a vehicle key. The victim stated that she and her husband had found someone had entered her garage and loaded some tools in her vehicle. Further she stated that someone had taken her husband's nylon bag containing clothing from the garage. Later that evening she reported that someone had entered her residence and gone to an upstairs kitchen and taken cash, and the key to a vehicle. A neighbor reported a W/M with brown hair was seen riding away from the residence between 730 and 800 am. The suspect appeared to be carrying the nylon bag. Attempts to gain prints was negative. A check of the neighborhood found no other witnesses and no video surveillance. To date there has been no new leads or incidents similar to this case. Case will be inactive pending new leads or a suspect in this case. Case Inactive.

130600005 06/06/13 (Theft, Petit) – Condo Association reports that someone stole a shopping cart owned by the association from the property. An individual observed the individual (who he could not identify) drop the cart from the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the building to a courtyard below. The cart was damaged in the fall. The male subject then met with a female and they both loaded the cart into a gold SUV. The witness took photos of both subjects as they took the cart and loaded it into the vehicle. These photos had been circulated around the condominium however to date the suspect has not been identified. As of this date no identification has been made on the suspects in this case. Case will remain open for another month as the photos will be re-circulated in an attempt to identify. Case Continued.

130600013 06/13/06 (Theft) – Victim reports that several pieces of jewelry are missing from her condominium. She thought that she had misplaced them however found several more pieces missing from the condo. She does not have a cleaning service however she does have pest control come in and she thinks that maintenance has keys, however there is no proof of this. There is no forced entry to the residence. Pawn checks have been made with negative results. Case Continued.

130600016 06/15/13 (Burglary) – Reporting party states that she is a real estate broker and someone entered a residence that she was in charge of, taking several items including a telescope. There was no forced entry however a side door to the residence was found open. Attempts to gain fingerprints were negative as the reporting party had used the possible unsecured door. Possible suspect fingerprints in residence was negative. No pawns in Volusia County matched missing scope. Victim advised when she was in area she would check to see if any other items were missing. To date the victim has not contacted PIPD to complete an affidavit or report any new items missing. Attempts to contact the victim have been negative. Case will remain open one more month in an attempt to gain further information. Case Continued.

130600029 06/28/13 (Theft) – Victim reports that a large amount of money was missing from his boat which was docked at Down the Hatch Boat Yard. The vessel is a charter fishing boat. There was signs of the vessel being ransacked however the only item missing is cash. There was no forced entry to vessel. Numerous persons have been interviewed and video reviewed with negative results. Case Continued.

She suspected two cleaning ladies one of whom had admired one of the missing necklaces. She suspected them because shortly after they cleaned one of them left town. Later in the month she contacted PIPD and advised that she had recovered the necklaces in another part of her residence. Case Closed Unfounded.

130700026 07/20/13 (Aggravated Battery) – A group of individuals went out to Disappearing Island for the day. While on the island an altercation occurred with an individual that was intoxicated. The altercation became physical with several individuals becoming involved. The group decided that they would leave the island. As one of the females was boarding the boat a male from the other boat threw a beer bottle at her head which shattered causing injuries, requiring medical attention. We now have several statements from witnesses positively identifying the suspect. Charges are pending. Case Continued.

130700031 07/23/13 (Carbreak) – Victim parked her vehicle at Oceanview off beach parking and went down to the beach. When she returned she found her rear passenger window broken and her purse missing. There were no witnesses to the incident however while checking with her credit card company she found that one of her cards had been used for gasoline in Daytona Beach. We traveled to the station where the card was used and did obtain some video, however the video is very grainy and identification of the suspects is not possible at this time. We are making arrangements to get the video enhanced for better identification. Case Continued.

130700032 07/23/13 (Carbreak) – This case is related to the above case as both vehicles were burglarized at the same time. Again the rear passenger window was broken out and an I-Pad taken from the back seat. Victim is attempting to get a serial number on missing I-Pad. Case Continued.
