130700031 07/23/13 (Carbreak) – Victim parked her vehicle at Oceanview off beach parking and went down to the beach. When she returned she found her rear passenger window broken and her purse missing. There were no witnesses to the incident however while checking with her credit card company she found that one of her cards had been used for gasoline in Daytona Beach. We traveled to the station where the card was used and did obtain some video, however the video is very grainy and identification of the suspects is not possible at this time. We are making arrangements to get the video enhanced for better identification. Case Continued.

130700032 07/23/13 (Carbreak) – This case is related to the above case as both vehicles were burglarized at the same time. Again the rear passenger window was broken out and an I-Pad taken from the back seat. Victim is attempting to get a serial number on missing I-Pad. Case Continued.

130800012 08/13/13 (Burglary) – Victim is a part time resident of the area and had her representative report that someone had entered their residence on S. Atlantic Ave. Entry was gained through a side door by prying the bolt lock out to open door. Several items including a bed, television, chairs, and kitchen supplies were taken. Several more expensive items were left behind. Locks were changed on the residence. No forensic evidence has been retrieved at this time. To date no new leads in this case have been found. Several persons have been Field Interviewed who were near the residence at unusual hours however no links were found. Case Continued.

130900002 09/01/13 (Auto Theft) – Victim parked his vehicle in an off beach parking area and left keys hidden near the vehicle. Someone took said vehicle after victim left for a short period to go to the beach. Two days later the vehicle was recovered by Holly Hill PD. Vehicle was processed and a suspect has been developed. Fingerprints and other evidence lead to the prime suspect in this case however at this time there is only proof of the suspect being in the vehicle and nothing to prove that he took the vehicle. Case Continued.

130900041 09/30/13 (Carbreak) – Victim reports that she parked her vehicle in a parking garage at her condominium. She left all doors unsecured when leaving the vehicle. When she returned approximately 12 hours later she found that her cell phone (which was left charging in the vehicle) was missing from the cup holder next to her seat. No fingerprints were found and attempts to call the phone were negative as it was turned off. No suspects at this time. Case Continued.

131000005 – 10/04/13 (Burglary) – Victim reports that someone entered his lanai area and took two wet suits and a surfboard. Said lanai had been left unsecure during the overnight hours There was no evidence to process. A check of all local surf shops and pawn shops were negative. Case Continued.

131000016 10/17/13 (Carbreak) – Victim parked his vehicle in a condominium over night. A check in the morning found that someone had entered the vehicle and taken several items of which one was a brand new IPAD. Attempts to ping on IPAD was negative however further followup did identify the suspect. After reviewing all evidence the suspect was charged with theft and Dealing in Stolen Property. Case Closed by Arrest

131000017 10/17/23 (carbreak) – The vehicle in this case is identical to the above case and occurred at the same time. Items from this case are not recovered at this time. See above case about suspect arrested. Case Closed.

131000029 10/25/13 Theft – Suspect stole a small outboard motor off a vessel parking by Sea Love Boat Works. No witnesses to the incident and no video surveillance. We have put out a flyer to other agencies looking for similar cases. All checks of pawns in area have been negative. Case Continued.
