160600055 06/29/2016 Burglary – Report received that someone entered a residence and removed a large amount of cash and jewelry from a safe. The entire residence was processed for physical evidence and video surveillance was secured. Information on the burglary was broadcast on local news broadcast, Crime Stoppers, and social media. We have identified a possible suspect in this case and are attempting to collect more evidence in order to affect an arrest. Case Continued.

160700053 07/26/16 Car Break – Four vehicles were broken into at Off Beach parking area. All four had windows broken out and had purses removed. In one case the purse contained a ring worth \$50,000. Information is being shared with Central Florida Intelligence Exchange in an attempt to identify suspects. To date no suspect information has been found. Case is Inactive pending new leads.

160900035 09/21/2016 Theft – PIPD originally responded to a local condominium in reference to a maintenance door being pried open. There was nothing found out of place in the room and originally it was reported as vandalism. Later it was determined that two bicycles had been stolen from an area just near the damaged door. The bicycles had been locked however the chains cut. No video surveillance available and no suspects. Case Inactive pending new leads.

160900047 09/25/2016 Burglary – Victim had left the area on vacation and had a relative checking his residence. During one of the checks it was found that someone had broken out a window to a back door and entered the residence. A desk top computer was found to be missing. Checks of local pawnshops for the missing computer were negative. Serial number for computer entered as stolen in NCIC/FCIC. Case Continued.

160900052 09/27/2016 Car Break – Several unlocked vehicles were broken into and numerous small items and change were taken. Two juveniles were identified and also video surveillance places them

at the scene of the incidents. Upon interviewing one of the suspects he confessed to breaking into the vehicles. Charges have been filed in this case with State Attorney. Case Closed Exceptionally.

161100002 11/02/2016 Theft – Victim reports that a pair of antique handcuffs and a digital camera were taken from her residence. The victim had an outside company come in to her residence to do some work and it is suspected that one of the employees may have taken the items. Case Continued.

161100012 11/11/16 Burglary – Victim reports that several televisions had been stolen from two residences that he owns. There was forced entry to the residences however repairs had been made by the time that the incidents were reported. The residences were processed for fingerprints and any other evidence that could be found. It should be noted that the victim had a residence in Daytona Beach Shores broken into in the previous month but had never been reported. Possible suspects include a cleaning and management company that manage the victim's residences. Case Continued.
