## COMMENTS

160600055 06/29/2016 Burglary – Report received that someone entered a residence and removed a large amount of cash and jewelry from a safe. The entire residence was processed for physical evidence and video surveillance was secured. Information on the burglary was broadcast on local news broadcast, Crime Stoppers, and social media. We have identified a possible suspect in this case and are attempting to collect more evidence in order to affect an arrest. Case Continued.

160700034 07/19/16 Theft – Victim reports that he had a tenant move out of a fully furnished condo and take with her furniture and personal belongings costing \$1,700. After identifying the suspect we have recovered some of the property from her however over \$1,400 is still unaccounted for. Complaint has been submitted to the State Attorney and they have determined they will file charges. Case Closed exceptionally.

160700053 07/26/16 Car Break – Four vehicles were broken into at Off Beach parking area. All four had windows broken out and had purses removed. In one case the purse contained a ring worth \$50,000. Information is being shared with Central Florida Intelligence Exchange in an attempt to identify suspects. Case Continued.

160900031 09/19.16 Car Break – Victim reported that during a one week time frame someone broke into her vehicle and stole some fishing equipment. There is no video surveillance of the incident and to date no suspects have been identified. There have been no new leads or evidence and this case is Inactive pending leads.

160900035 09/21/2016 Theft – PIPD originally responded to a local condominium in reference to a maintenance door being pried open. There was nothing found out of place in the room and originally it was reported as vandalism. Later it was determined that two bicycles had been stolen

Checks of local pawnshops for the missing computer were negative. Serial number for computer entered as stolen in NCIC/FCIC. Case Continued.

160900052 09/27/2016 Car Break – Several unlocked vehicles were broken into and numerous small items and change were taken. Two juveniles were identified and also video surveillance places them at the scene of the incidents. Upon interviewing one of the suspects he confessed to breaking into the vehicles. Case is submitted to the State Attorney for charges. Case Continued.

161000041 10/31/2016 Theft – Victim reports that a pair of antique handcuffs and a digital camera were taken from her residence. The victim had an outside company come in to her residence to do some work and it is suspected that one of the employees may have taken the items. Case Continued.
