PROCLAMATION OF THE TOWN OF PONCE INLET, FLORIDA

EXECUTIVE ORDER *DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY*

WHEREAS, Hurricane Matthew is expected to strike Volusia County during the week of October 3, 2016 possibly resulting in extensive flooding and tornadoes; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Matthew presents a clear and present danger to private homes, utility systems, public drainage systems, public streets and other structures; and

WHEREAS, Section 26-7 of the Town of Ponce Inlet Code of Ordinances and Section 252.38(3)(a)(5), Fla. Stat. authorizes the declaration of a state emergency by executive order under these circumstances; and

WHEREAS, this declaration will permit Town officials to waive specified procedures and regulations in order to preserve the welfare of its citizens and property until this state of emergency passes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

Effective immediately this 5th day of October, 2016 a state of local emergency is declared, effective for seven (7) day period ending on the 12th day of October 2016. This Executive Order shall be extended, as necessary, for seven (7) day increments upon the authority of the undersigned or other officials as provided by Section 26-6 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. EFFECT

Pursuant to Section 252.38(3)(a)(5), Fla. Stat., this Executive Order will permit the Town Manager or her designee to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the Town, by law, pertaining to the following:

- a. Performance of public work and taking whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the community.
- b. Entering into contracts.
- c. Incurring obligations.
- d. Employment of permanent and temporary workers.
- e. Utilization of volunteer workers.
- f. Rental of equipment.
- g. Acquisition and distribution, with or without compensation, of supplies, materials and facilities.
- h. Appropriation and expenditure of public funds.


SECTION 3. AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE


Pursuant to Section 26-6 of the Code of Ordinances, this Executive Order may be promulgated by the Mayor; or the Vice-Mayor in the event of incapacitation or absence of the Mayor from the Town; or in the absence from the Town or incapacitation of both the Mayor and the Vice-Mayor, then such promulgation may be made by any Town Councilmember.

SECTION 4. TERMINATION

The terms of this Executive Order shall terminate upon a declaration made by any competent and appropriate authority ending the state of emergency.
