### Report to Town Council

**Topic:** Ordinance 2016-01, amending the Town Code to reduce the number of members on the Parks, Recreation & Tree Advisory Board from seven members to five members.

**Recommended Motion:** Approval of the first reading of Ordinance 2016-01.

**Summary:** Pursuant to the direction of the Town Council at their January 21, 2016 meeting, this ordinance has been prepared to reduce the membership composition of the Parks, Recreation and Tree Advisory Board from seven members to five members. The number of board alternate positions will remain at two.

The board currently has five members and no alternates, so there is no change to the actual member composition with this amendment.

The reduction in membership requirement will reduce the number of members needed for a quorum from four to three, following second reading / adoption of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE 2016-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PONCE INLET, FLORIDA AMENDING THE TOWN'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 46, ARTICLE II, SECTIONS 46-32 and 33, , AS THEY RELATE TO THE COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND TREE ADVISORY BOARD; AMENDING THE TOWN'S LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 6.2.4, AS IT RELATES TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND TREE ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Ponce Inlet has established certain advisory board duties to the Parks, Recreation and Tree Advisory Board and seeks to ensure that the board's composition is most appropriate to the successful performance of these duties;

WHEREAS, the Town's current composition requirement of seven regular members and two alternates has been difficult to maintain over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has revisited this issue of board vacancies many times and has now made a decision that it is in the best interest of conducting the business of the Town to reduce the composition of the Parks, Recreation and Tree Advisory Board to five members and two alternates.

NOTE: Underlined words constitute additions to the Town of Ponce Inlet Code of Ordinances and the Land Use and Development Code, strikethrough constitutes deletions from the original Code or Land Use and Development Code, and asterisks (\*\*\*) indicate an omission from the existing text which is intended to remain unchanged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PONCE INLET, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Town of Ponce Inlet Code of Ordinances, Chapter 46, Article II, Sections 46-32 and 33 are hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE II. - PARKS, RECREATION AND TREE ADVISORY BOARD

35 Sec. 46-32. - Composition.

36 The parks, recreation and tree advisory board shall consist of ~~seven~~ five members and two  
37 alternates. At least two of the members shall have an interest in trees and the perpetuation and  
38 care of trees on public property.

39 Sec. 46-33. - Appointment and term of members.

40 The members and alternates of the parks, recreation and tree advisory board shall be appointed  
41 by the town council and shall serve ~~staggered terms to be determined by lot drawing for one,~~  
42 ~~two, and three years. Subsequent members to the original board shall serve three year terms in~~  
43 ~~staggered sequence.~~ three-year staggered terms, with an exception for the initial terms of  
44 members on this newly established five member board: terms for seats one and three shall expire  
45 in December 2016, terms for seats two and four shall expire in December 2018, and the term for  
46 seat five shall expire in December 2017. Alternate members shall be appointed to an annual  
47 term ending in December of each year.

49 **SECTION 2. The Town of Ponce Inlet Land Use and Development Code, Section**  
50 **6.2.4 is hereby amended as follows:**

51 Section 6.2.4 - Parks, recreation and tree advisory board.

53 B. *Membership and terms of office.* The parks, recreation and tree advisory board shall  
54 consist of ~~seven~~ five regular members and two alternates appointed by the town council. Each  
55 regular member shall be appointed for a three-year term in staggered sequence. Alternate  
56 members shall be appointed for a term of one year.

58 **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

59 If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or  
60 unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, that holding in no way affects the  
61 remaining portions of this Ordinance.

62 **SECTION 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

63 All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

64 **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE**

65 This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
