Certain standards of basic fairness must be adhered to in order to afford due process. The parties must receive notice of all hearings and be able to present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, and be informed of all the facts upon which a Quasi-Judicial board acts. It shall be the responsibility of the APPLICANT to ensure that the proposal meets all the criteria and standards established in the Land Use and Development Code for the development sought. Procedure for Public Hearings:
 1. Reading of the Item for the Record;
 2. Staff Testimony, including noticing information;
 3. Board Discussion;
 4. Public Discussion, including statement of Applicant(s);
 5. Boardmembers individually complete Quasi-Judicial worksheets (if applicable);
 6. Motion and Second by the Board; followed by Board discussion, and
 7. Roll-call Vote.
